

Roberts Ridge Trail

Roberts Regional Recreation Area

Trail Length 0.4 mi (0.7 km)

Network trail

This trail offers a variety of tread challenges, like roots, rock and puddles, depending on the time of year. The lush vegetation and tree cover provides a sense of solitude, though the trail is located close to Skyline Blvd.

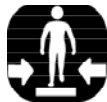
Typical Grade is 8.3%

8% of the trail is between 16% and 18%
0 ft (0 m) is between 20% and 18%
8% grade is a standard ramp.



Typical Cross Slope is 3.9%

9% of the trail is between 8% and 13%
192 ft (59 m) is between 8% and 13%



Typical Tread Width is 90 in (229 cm)

Tread Width ranges from 0 in (0 cm) to 132 in (335 cm)



Trail Surface is Soil

52% of the trail is Firm or better
1063 ft (324 m) of the trail is Soft or worse

This trail can be accessed from main parking lot within the park.
A second access point is from the Chabot Space And Science Center.



Trail Access Information

Obstructions less than 4 in or outside the tread area 72 in wide by 96 in (24 m) high were not measured. Minimum clearance boundaries were at least 4 in high.
